Bronze Age - Adam to Gideon

- Term - disputed today - "Biblical" vs "Palestinian" (false dichotomy)
- Arch. illuminates the Bible
 - { Understanding of language
 - { illucidates the text
 - { Authenticates the Bible (setting record straight) disproves critics, supports Bible)
- 2 Categories
 1. Written - (most impn) stone, clay, metal, parchment, papyrus, ostraca
 2. Unwritten (buildings, vessels, art, jewelry, tools, weapons)

Types

1. Surface surveys
2. Diggings - tests

Methodology (What to do in beginning a dig? (Kenyon developed))

1. levels of strata - periods charact. by types of architecture
2. target acropolis - high pt. of tell - over the gate
3. Stratigraphic excavation at 5' mt "fields", leave "bulks" in strata
4. Recording units as locus (distinguishable material) + locus numbers

- C. Fisher's method - Israel (less careful)

- Wheeler-Kenyon - Amman (careful)

Dating

1. pottery (5500 BC begins)
2. writing (and esp. Bible)
3. Coins (500 BC →)
4. Jewelry
5. Carbon 14

Agess

1. Bronze - Egyptian correlations (astronomical) fix dates; low chronol
2. Irons - Stone - Bronze - Iron -
 - Albright established at Tel-Bet-Mirsim (Debir?)
 - { suffered many destructions, left unoccupied after Iron II
 - { arbitrary hist. correlations + dates
