SOCIAL AND MORAL EVILS OF ISLAM

The present social and moral condition of The Law of Mohammedan lands and of Moslems in all lands Effect is not such as it is in spite of, but because of their religion. The law of cause and effect has operated for over a thousand years under every possible natural and political environment, among Semites, Negroes, Aryan races, and Slavs. The results are so sadly similar that they form a terrible and unanswerable indictment of the social and moral weakness of Islam. There is no better proof of the inadequacy of the religion of Mohammed than a study of the present intellectual, social, and moral conditions in Moslem lands. What those conditions are we know from the testimony of travelers, politicians, and diplomats, as well as from the missionaries themselves. The purely Mohammedan lands like Arabia, Persia, Morocco, and Afghanistan are at the antipodes of civilization after thirteen centuries of Moslem rule. The reason for it is found first of all in the character of Mohammed
